Safe Environment Policy for All Parish & Academy of Our Lady Volunteers

Compliance of the Archdiocese of Newark's **Safe Environment Policy** is required for all volunteers and employees (18 years/older) who work/volunteer with children in our parish or at Academy of Our Lady. This includes all classroom, lunch & library volunteers, class parents, HSA members, coaches, Scout leaders, CCD teachers & aides, CYO chaperones, etc.

Safe Environment Policy requirements include:

- 1) Attending a **Protecting God's Children Workshop** (recertification of PGC is required every 3 yrs)
- 2) Completing a **Volunteer Application** and **Archdiocesan Code of Conduct**
- 3) Completing a **Criminal Background Check**.
